## RESOLUTION (#10-32)

## AMENDING RESOLUTION DEFINING RESPONSIBLE BIDDER

WHEREAS, in many instances and circumstances the County is required to let contracts to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously adopted a resolution on December 9, 1997, defining the term "responsible bidder" and wishes to amend the definition of the term "responsible bidder".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the LaSalle County Board as follows:

Section 1: That the term "responsible bidder" for construction contracts means a bidder who meets all of the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance;

- (1) All applicable laws pre-requisite to doing business in Illinois,
- (2) Evidence of compliance with
  - (a) federal employer tax identification number or social security number (for individuals);
  - (b) provision of Section 2000(e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer provisions).
- (3) Certificates of insurance indicating the following coverages; general Liability, worker's compensation, completed operations, automobile, hazardous occupation, product liability, and professional liability in compliance with County of LaSalle Resolution setting forth minimum insurance requirements for contractors and subcontractors
- (4) Compliance with all provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, Including wages, medical and hospitalization insurance and retirement for those trades as covered in the "Act".
- (5) The bidder and all bidder's sub-contractors must participate in active apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training for each of the trades of work contemplated under the awarded contract.
- (6) All contractors and sub-contractors are required to turn in certified payrolls as specified in Illinois Public Act 94-0515.

<u>Section 2</u>: Any prior Resolution or portion thereof, in conflict with this Resolution is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing herein shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court or any rights accrued or liability incurred or cause or causes of action accrued or existing under any prior Resolution of Ordinance. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
